### Entry requirements

Students are required to:

- Hold a qualification at Certificate III level or higher in Community Services, Health or related field
- Have skills equivalent to the qualification requirement validated through a recognition of prior learning process.

### Funding requirements

Students must be a New or Existing Worker in the Community Services and Health Industry in a role involving the provision of direct client care or support. Students must already hold a Certificate III in Individual Support (or equivalent).



### Workplace practical requirements

Students may be required to undertake practical workplace tasks in an approved workplace/environment to complete their qualifications. This will be discussed with your Educator or CA Mentor.
