STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

HEALTH INSURANCE

Australia has a health insurance system for international students called Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC). International students studying in Australia must have health and medical insurance for the length of their student visa.

College Australia can assist you in arranging health insurance; however, you also can arrange your cover if you wish. This insurance covers you for general medical treatment or hospital care in Australia. A number of additional services, including dental, physiotherapy, optometry, chiropractic and private hospital services, may require you to purchase extra cover from your OSHC provider.

GETTING A VISA

To study in Australia, you must obtain a student visa (Subclass 500). This visa allows you to stay in Australia to study full-time in a recognised education institution.

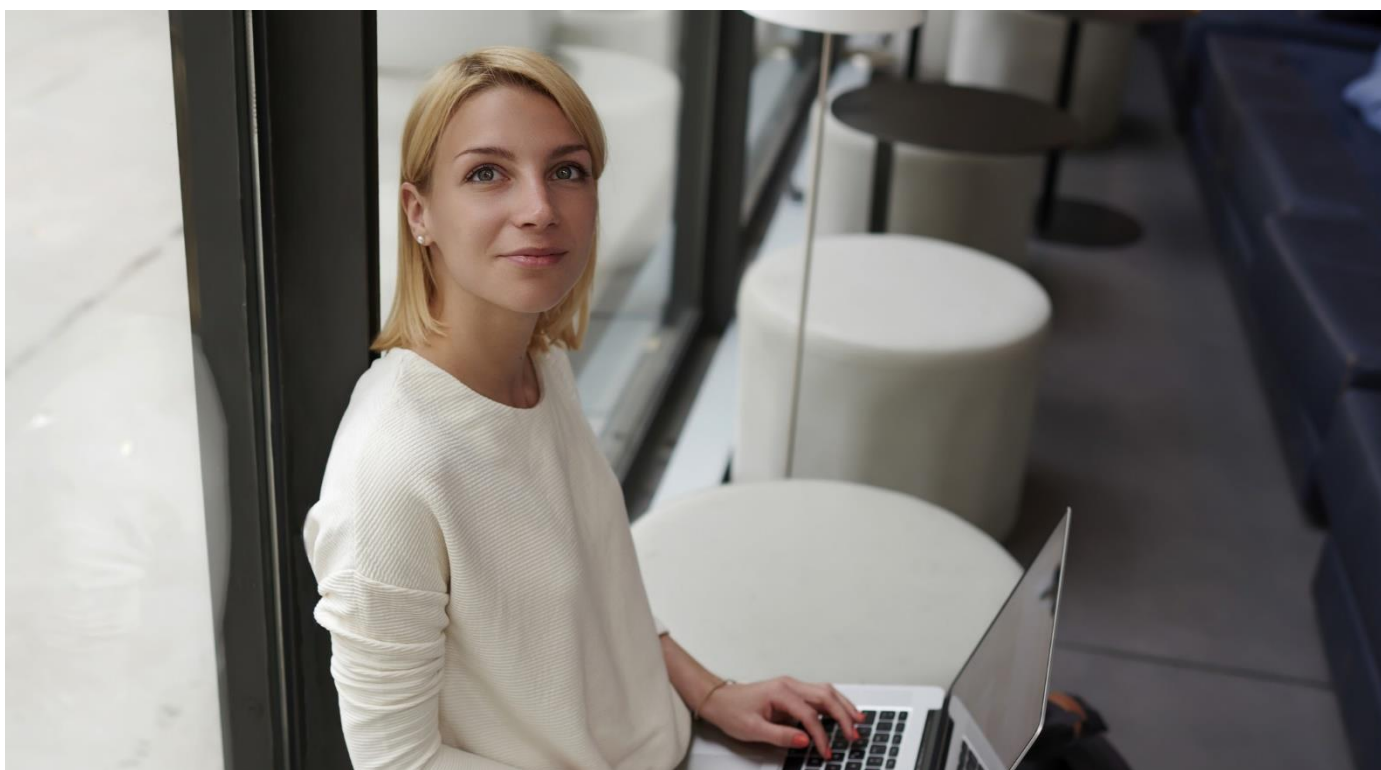
ELIGIBILITY

You must:

- be at least six years of age
- have been accepted to study at an educational institution in Australia
- have health insurance.

DETAILS

- You may stay up to five years
- Costs start at \$560

A place to stay

There are a range of accommodation options available on the Gold Coast to suit your needs and budget. The most common types of accommodation are homestay, student accommodation and rentals.

DORMITORY

Specialised student accommodation facilities can be a great place to live in a communal atmosphere and meet other local and international students. In most student accommodation you'll rent a private room in a dormitory-style environment and share common facilities such as living areas and kitchens with your fellow students. Many student accommodation facilities also have in-house Residential Coordinators (RAs) who organise social, cultural, and sporting activities for residents.

HOMESTAY

Homestay gives you the opportunity to live with an Aussie family in their home. Homestay can be a great option for younger students as you will have a supportive family environment and a home away from home. Some homestay options include meals and others are self-catered, so you can choose an option that best suits you.

RENTAL ACCOMMODATION

Another accommodation option is to rent your own apartment or share a room, flat or house. In a rental arrangement, each person usually has their own bedroom and shares the bathroom, kitchen and living areas with housemates. Many students choose student accommodation or homestay for their first semester and then move onto rental accommodation once they've settled into the area and have a better idea of where they would like to live and the type of accommodation they'd prefer.

ENGLISH REQUIREMENTS

College Australia wants to ensure you achieve academic success, so you need to have a minimum level of academic and English language proficiency before being enrolled into one of our programs. The minimum level entry requirement is IELTS 5.5 (no individual band less than 5.0), completion of year 12 or equivalent and be at least 18 years old before commencement of the course.

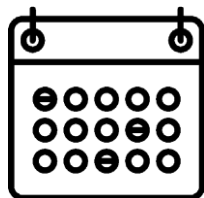
Please note: Mature age students (at least 21 years of age) with relevant work experience may be exempt from the academic entry requirements.

We accept additional English language skills tests: TOEFL iBT, TOEFL PB, PTE, Cambridge English Scale, ISLPR and selected Year 12 English subjects.
